Dear brothers and sisters,

As you sit here in God's house today, I ask you to consider the immense blessing you have as a member of the RCUS, that you can confidently know that your pastor, who expounds God's Word to you each Lord's Day, does so as an approved and trained man, educated in a faithful seminary with the essential tools to read the Bible in its original languages and to have a thorough understanding of it and the derived creeds and confessions of our Reformed Faith, that he might faithfully convey the truth of the gospel we so need to hear.

Thank God for that, for not all of our brothers and sisters around the world have that same blessing of having a pastor, let alone a trained pastor to feed and nurture them. How can you help? By graciously supporting one of the seminaries which exist within our denomination. Heidelberg Theological Seminary, since 2017, has been actively providing both remote and live training to over 60 men in the Philippines and recently eleven men in Kenya towards an MDiv degree, with the first eight men due to graduate this summer!

This cost-effective approach to providing the required level of training to these men comes at a fraction of the cost of either them coming to the US to study or us sending pastors there either intermittently or long term. Heidelberg is committed to this work of helping these brothers, but Heidelberg desperately needs your financial help to continue this work.
